### THE PRESERVE IS FOR USE DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS ONLY

The following are PROHIBITED on this preserve:

- Overnight camping
- Nudity
- Possession of alcohol or illegal drugs
- Use or disposal of glass containers
- Trash dumping
- Camp fires or smoking
- Motorized vehicles
- Discharging of firearms
- Disturbance of vegetation or wildlife, except for picking edible plants, or as permitted under state fish and wildlife laws.
- Unleashed pets. Pet owners should remove pet wastes from walking trails.

### LAW VIOLATIONS ARE ENFORCED BY THE RICHMOND POLICE DEPARTMENT

This property is owned by the Richmond Land Trust, a private organization dedicated to conserving significant natural areas and agricultural and forest lands in Richmond, Vermont. The Lower Gorge Preserve was established to preserve the wild character of the land, to conserve habitat for native wildlife and plants, to protect the spectacular geologic features of the Huntington River, and to provide public access to the land and river for hiking, swimming, fishing, picnicking, nature study, and enjoyment of the outdoors. The preserve is managed by the Lower Gorge Preserve Management Committee.
